Skelmersdale Catholic Churches Sacramental Programme

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am happy to inform you that our Sacramental Programme (Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion) for 2025/2026 will begin on the weekend of 27/28 September 2025. The programme is open to all children who will be in Year 4 or above in September and who have been baptised.

Sacraments like Reconciliation and First Communion are part of God's gift to us. Reconciliation is the gift of forgiveness and through Eucharist we come into communion with Jesus. The journey to a child's First Communion is an important and joyful occasion for them. As parents during Baptism you accepted the responsibility of helping your child in the practice of the Catholic Faith. The parish community also promised to support you in these duties. So as you walk with your child on this journey our parish community is here to help you.

The First Communion programme we use is based on the completion of a handbook. It is designed to help your child understand the meaning of Eucharist and deepen their relationship with Jesus. Children and parents attend one session a month at Mass to work on the programme. A Catechist leads the children's session during Mass and the parents are asked to attend a 10 minute session at the end of Mass. Parents pick one church to attend. Dates will be confirmed at the first session but are generally the third weekend in the month.

Mass times are: Saturday 5 pm in St Mary

Sunday 9 am in St Richard's Sunday 11am in St Francis'

You can attend any church and you do not need to attend the same Church each month as central attendance records are kept. If you wish your child to join the programme complete the attached Registration form and bring your child to one of the churches on 27th or28th. Forms can be returned to school or brought to Church.

We ask for a voluntary £5 contribution towards the cost of the file and worksheets. Please put it in the envelope with your form and either return it to school or bring it to church. Please do not let finance determine whether your child receives Communion as we can help in various ways.
